### **OFFICE VISITS**

Our office staff will call you before you are discharged from the hospital when born at Norton Women's & Children's Hospital or Baptist East Hospital. If your infant is born at another hospital, please call our office when you are discharged to schedule your infants' Newborn Visit with one of our providers. Following this appointment your baby's next regular check-up will be at 1 month of age.

### LAB TESTS

- 1. Newborn Screening is performed on all babies after they are 24 hours old. We will review the results of these tests on your baby's one month visit. If any of these results are abnormal, you will be notified.
- 2. Jaundice: If your baby is jaundiced on the day of discharge, you might be asked to return to the outpatient lab at the hospital for follow-up lab test.

### SAFE RIDE HOME/TRANSITION HOME

Be sure your infant's seat is installed properly, and your infant is safely secured for the first ride home. All other passengers should also be properly restrained. Your first few days and nights will be a time of adjustment for you and your baby. Try to take it easy, limit visitors, and exhausting activities. Settle into your life with your baby as calmly and confidently as possible. Babies are wonderful people! They need you to fall in love with them and learn how to recognize their cries for food, warmth, and comfort. As the days pass, you will grow in your ability to recognize and meet their needs. We are available to answer any questions you may have!
